Coventry and Central Warwickshire TSH has been successful in being

redesignated by the DfE and we will continue to serve schools in our region and beyond until at least **August 2028**.

Thank you to all of our partner schools and delivery partners who have engaged with the hub and the training we have provided over the last three years of our designation. In our first 3 years of designation, we have provided training and support to **261 schools**, **281 school leaders**, **over 600 mentors and over 600 ECTs** across the Coventry and Central Warwickshire region. We are really excited to continue this journey with you all!

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NPQ - Funding

The DfE changed the <u>funding arrangements for NPQ qualifications for the Autumn 2024 cohort</u> and we await eagerly for the announcement about funding for the Spring 2025 cohort. If you, or a member of your staff, are interested in undertaking an NPQ then please <u>explore our website</u>. Coventry and Central Warwickshire TSH work closely with <u>UCL's Centre for Educational Leadership</u> to deliver the full suite of NPQ qualifications.

Early Career Framework (ECF) & Appropriate Body Services (AB)

We continue to offer the <u>ECF Full Induction Programme</u> and <u>Appropriate Body services</u> to ECTs from September 2024.

Do you have new ECTs joining your school?

Make sure that they are registered for both an ECF programme and are registered with an Appropriate Body. It's important to get any new ECTs and their mentors registered for both

elements of the Induction Programme as soon as they start with you, whatever point in the academic year. Email us at <u>tshub@lawrencesheriffschool.com</u> to find out about the registration process.

Did you know that some ECTs are eligible for retention incentive payments?

ECTs working in some shortage subjects (Chemistry, Computing, Maths, Physics) in secondary schools within an education investment area may be eligible for an incentive retention payment of up to $\pm 6,000 - \underline{\text{find out more at the DfE website.}}$ Many of the schools in our area will be eligible for this incentive.

Changes to ITT mentoring requirements

In September 2024 new DfE reforms for Initial Teacher Training (ITT) came into effect, <u>including new funding that schools who host trainees can access</u>. There are several new requirements that all accredited providers must adhere to.
